

JET and Full-text Access to e-Journals

J-Gate Engineering & Technology (JET) is a database for searching and accessing articles online from 4670+ e-Journals in Engineering, Technology and related disciplines. Of these, full-text accesses to 1,800 journals are available through JET as part of Library's subscription to JET.

Full-text Journals in J-Gate

- Full text links are provided for all the articles indexed in JET. The following are the methods to access fulltext of articles
 - For 1,800 Full text journals (10 Lakhs articles) available through JET as part of JET subscription, users can view articles online automatically by clicking on the "Free Full Text" link provided against each article.
 - For all the e-journals subscribed by the library (including the journals that the library will be subscribing under AICTE's recommended norms) clicking on the "Full Text" links will take the user to the article.
 - IP enable access: Click on fulltext will lead you automatically to fulltext if the library has IP enabled access for those subscribed journals.
 - Userid/Password access: For libraries that have opted for userid/password based access, users will be asked to enter userid/password when clicked on Full text links.
 - Full text link will not work for the remaining journals. Librarians will have to make aware their users to contact the library for help if users need articles from those journals. (In the new version of JET ready for release during first quarter 2012, Full-text links for this category of journals will be removed.)
 - For journals and articles not available through any of these sources, Librarians can also help their users by providing document delivery services through agencies like DELNET, Delhi, British Library, UK, CISTI, Canada, etc., or from the publishers.

Feature available in JET

- Provides single point search facility for all the 4670 journals and 40 lakhs articles.
- Journals are classified (3 level hierarchical system) to provide a better relevancy and search experience.
- JET database is updated daily.
- Article Search: There are 2 level search facility provided in JET, "Quick Search" and "Advance Search".
 - Quick search provides options to limit results to Peer - Reviewed or Professional & Industry journals.

- o Using the Advance Search feature the user can search by a combination of search terms such as:
 - Title words
 - Keywords
 - Author name
 - Author's Institution/city/country
 - Journal Name
 - Period of Publications
- Browse Table of Content (TOC): provides table of contents service for all the journals indexed. The users can browse through an A-Z list of journals and browse TOCs from the latest issue or the back issues. The user can also select journals by subject for browsing TOC.
- Alerts: Provides a facility of TOC alerts from the latest issues of journals, which can be personalized for every user and for his choice of journals.
