



































Report - Blood Donation Camp (26.09.2019)

UNNAT BHARAT ABHIYAN - ANNUAL REPORT (2019-20)

Awareness activity on "Health, Nutrition, Sanitation & Environmental Pollution" performed by Team Members of IMSEC on 22nd Nov. 2019

The aim of Unnat Bharat Abhiyan is to enable higher educational institutions to work with the people of rural India in identifying development challenges and evolving appropriate solutions for accelerating sustainable growth. With this objective five villages had been assigned to IMSEC, to develop them & provide them better solutions of their problems.

To start with the same on 22nd Nov. 2019 a team comprising of Prof. Rashmi Chandra (H.O.D. Department of Biotechnology), Dr. Shashi Gupta (Associate Professor, Department of M.B.A.), & Dr. Suman Gupta (Assistant Professor, Department of Applied Science), Mr. Sudhir Chaudhary (Administration officer), Mr. Amit Tyagi (System Administration Officer), from IMSEC went in a govt. school of Rasulpur Sikrod village to educate students about Health, Nutrition, Sanitation & Environment Pollution. Along with the team members of college, school principle Mohd. Haneef, Smt. Prachi Tyagi (Teacher), Mr. Sandeep Kumar (Assistant Teacher) & village head Smt. Khushnuma and her husband Shri Fakhru Bhaiya authorities were also present there. Team also went to another govt. school in village Nahal to educate the students about environmental management.

Health forms an Important index of human development and in turn that of the development of any society. It is the fundamental human right. Healthy population plays a key role in achieving the developmental activities as health helps to improve the productivity of mankind both directly and indirectly. With this objective Prof. Rashmi Chandra talked about Health & Nutrition. She told the students about the Components of food, Importance of food, Healthy food & Nutrients required by human body.

If water is life, sanitation is surely a 'way of life' and access to such facilities has an impact on the quality of human life and health. Environmental cleanliness and sanitation were subjects closest to Mahatma Gandhi's heart who proclaimed that 'cleanliness is next only to godliness'. Keeping in mind this view Dr. Shashi Gupta told the students about health and sanitation, purpose of sanitation & diseases which are caused due to lack of sanitation. Failing to ensure sanitation can have direct implications on the individual/family/community's health.

Dr. Suman Gupta told the students about Environmental pollution & Health. She told the students about the pollution, causes of pollution, types of pollution & effect rising pollution on the human body. She also told the students about how they can stay healthy in such a polluted environment.



Educational Programme on Environmental Management Organised by IMSEC, Ghaziabad in Purve Madhyamic Vidayalya, Nahal, Razapur, Ghaziabad, Uttar Pradesh, India.

IMS Engineering College (IMSEC) Ghaziabad organized an Educational tour in Purve Madhyamic Vidayalya (U.P.S. Nahal Middle School) in Village Nahal on Tuesday, 4th February 2020.

This school was established in 1997 by the State Government. U.P.S. Nahal Middle School (UPSNMS) located at Nahal, Ghaziabad. This school is counted among the top-rated Schools in Uttar Pradesh with an excellent academic track record. School type is Coeducational. Medium of instruction is Hindi. The name of school Head Master is Mr. Fazar Mohammad and there are 4 teachers besides him. There are approx 300 students in this school and ratio of boys and girls is 70 & 30 percent. A total of approx 150 students had attended this



educational program based on environmental management. The students belong to 6th to 8th standard.


Dr Suman Gupta, the faculty of IMSEC conducted a very informative session on removal of dust and smoke from polluted air by traditional Indian medicinal plantation method in villages and rural area without spending extra money and labour. Dr. Suman introduced the students to various enriching, purifying & medicinal aspects of traditional plants and trees as Bargad (*Ficus benghalensis*), Peepal (*Ficus religiosa*), Goolar (*Ficus glomerata*), Neem (*Azadirachta indica*) & Ghiquar (*Aloe vera*). She has explained the phenomenon of air purification which occurs in the plants and trees. She has given the informative talk on topics that included Medicinal uses, Air pollution management and Soil fertility improvement with the help of these traditional trees and plants.

At the end of the session questions were asked from the students. They also given answers and were very happy. Students were very enthusiastic. They took keen interest. Overall objective of the team was to create awareness about health and environment pollution among the children, who are the future of the nation.



Head Master and teachers had also taken keen interest in this traditional information. They appreciated this valuable information. It was a very informative, interesting and a successful Educational Programme. Mr. Sudhir Chaudhary (PI Coordinator), Mr. Amit Tyagi, Mr. Jitendra Kumar and Mr. Nishant (student of MBA) are supportive members from IMSEC for this meaningful program. 




