Dear Sir/Madam, In response to your communication seeking clarification: In the approval letter of session 2017-18, IMS Engineering College had 180 seats in Computer Science & Engineering in 1st Shift and 60 seats in 2nd shift. However, in session 2018-19, IMS Engineering College applied for conversion of 2nd shift seats to 1st shift. AICTE Approved the same and then mentioned 180 seats in the 1st shift and 60 seats separately as the converted seat (from 2nd shift to 1st shift) in the approval letter, please refer F.No. Northern/1-3511337920/2018/EOA date 10/04/2017. Whereas the affiliating University Dr. A.P.J Abdul Kalam Technical University merged both these into a single category i.e. Computer Science & Engineering in the approval letter and made one branch Computer Science & Engineering and made it 240 seats, ref AKTU/2018/10139/(143) date 15/05/2017. In the session 2020-21 also, AICTE Response: issue a similar approval letter ref F.No. Northern/1-7013710200/2020/EOA date 15/06/2020 but the shift column deleted from the letter, and Dr. A.P.J Abdul Kalam

Technical University merged 180 and 60 seats to one Computer Science & Engineering and made it 240 seats since 2018-19. Therefore, in 2020-21, the AICTE approval letter has 180 seats and 60 seats of the Computer Science and Engineering branch separately, and the Dr. A.P.J Abdul Kalam Technical University approval letter has only one branch, Computer Science and Engineering have 240 seats.
