Basic Guidelines for Funded Projects:

- The entire sanctioned amount shall be utilized as per the guidelines of the funding agency
- In case the Principal Investigator leaves the Institution, all the items purchased shall remain as an asset of the Institution. In case of ongoing projects, the responsibility will be delegated to other competent staff members as per the norms of the sponsoring agency.
- All Heads of the Department must regularly and diligently update the R&D information on the Institution website and submit the reports to R&D team.

• Every project preferably leads to at least one research publication in a journal indexed in SCI/SCOPUS/UGC approved journals.

Basic Guidelines for Patents:

Receiving patent for one's research work is one of the most important factors denoting the quality of research. Financial and legal assistance shall be provided to those who are interested in registering for the patent. The patent shall irrevocably be registered in the name of IMSEC with the researcher's name prominently featuring as the inventor. The commercial aspects shall be mutually worked-out between the Institution and the researcher.

General Guidelines:

The general guidelines for faculty members of institution are:

- 1. Every faculty member should attend at least one FDP/Workshop/Short Term Training Program (online/offline) of minimum 5 days in an academic year.
- 2. Every faculty member should publish at least two research papers in an academic year. One paper may be in reputed journal (SCI/SCOPUS/UGC/WoS indexed journals) and other should be presented in international conference (IEEE/SCOPUS indexed).
- 3. The published papers must have "IMS Engineering College, Ghaziabad" as the affiliation. The author needs to claim the incentive only after the volume number, issue number, and page number have been assigned to the research paper and it is available online.
- 4. All the claims must be applied **through proper channel** (through R & D Cell) and will be settled at the **end of academic year**.
- 5. A maximum of 5 days "ON DUTY" leave may be granted in an academic year for research activities. Leaves must be pre-sanction by concerned HOD and Director.
- 6. Faculty member has to handover the C.D./proceedings and related material to the central library through the HoD for the conferences attended.
- 7. Faculty who attend FDPs must disseminate knowledge and information by organising Student Development Programmes (SDP)/Student Workshops/ Presentation, for the benefit of faculty and students in their respective departments.

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

is made on the 3rd of February, 2021

Between

IMS Engineering College, National Highway 24, Near Dasna, Adhyatmik Nagar, Ghaziabad, U.P (201015)

AND

Codon Biotech Private Limited (CBPL) 153, Vardhaman City Centre, Gulabi Bagh, Delhi - 110037

Background

- i. IMS Engineering College, Ghazlabad (IMSEC) is an engineering institute in north India running B.Tech and M.Tech courses in various branches of science and technology. Its Biotechnology Department is NBA accredited and runs B.Tech, M.Tech courses in Biotechnology. It is also an authorised research centre of AKTU for PhD course while Codon Biotech Private Limited (CBPL) having its registered address at 153, Vardhaman City Centre, Gulabi Bagh, Delhi, is a biotechnology company that manufactures wide spectrum testing kits and share interests in both Research & Academics.
- The two Parties have identified that a stronger relationship between them is mutually beneficial and wish to establish a more formal relationship with each other.

Commencement

This Memorandum of Understanding ("MOU") shall take effect on the date of signing and shall continue for a period of 5 years unless terminated earlier in accordance with the provisions of Clause 6.

Scope of MOU

The areas of agreement outlined in this MOU are described to facilitate more detailed and specific negotiations between the parties which may lead to the preparation and signing of one or more formal agreements between BT-IMSEC and CBPL unless specifically noted herein. This MOU is not intended to be of legal force and effect in any manner whatsoever. This MOU shall not create a legal relationship between the parties.





Broad Areas for Cooperation

BT-IMSEC and CBPL will discuss the possibility of cooperation in the following areas:

- I. Research collaborations
- II. Joint PhD guide
- III. Student Training
- IV. Student Placement

Representatives of the Parties may agree to review the operation of this MOU from time to time.

1. Joint Contributions

- 1.1. Potential areas for collaborative research will be identified and recorded in subsequent research specific agreement(s) that set out appropriate and relevant contributions by the Parties. These may include:
 - (a) Access to its research laboratories and assist in development of projects involving the parties.
 - (b) Joint submission of research proposals to national and international organisations to obtain support for their common research objectives.
 - (c) BT-IMSEC and CBPL shall work specifically in the areas defined in Para 1.1 and para 3.1.
- 1.2. The parties acknowledge that all specific financial arrangements proposed must be negotiated and will depend upon the availability of funds and organizational approvals.

2. Confidentiality and Privacy

- 2.1. BT-IMSEC and CBPL recognize that they will come into possession of information which the other considers to be confidential, including Personal Information ("Personal Information" means information and opinions recorded in any form about an individual whose identity is apparent, or can reasonably be ascertained, from the information or opinion). Each of CBPL and BT-IMSEC covenants and agrees that it shall not, at any time, disclose to any third party, any confidential information of another party without first having obtained the prior written consent of the other party.
- 2.2. The provisions of this Clause 5 are intended to and shall be binding upon the parties upon signing of this MOU, and shall survive till the termination or expiry of this MOU.





3. Intellectual Property

- 3.1. "Intellectual Property" means and includes all copyright, all rights in relation to inventions (including patent rights), plant varieties, register and unregistered trade marks, registered and unregistered designs and all other rights resulting form intellectual activity in the scientific, industrial, literary or artistic fields.
- 3.2. Each party shall retain all rights to existing intellectual property belonging to it and contributed by it ("Background IP") at the commencement of each Research Project arising under this Agreement.
- 3.3. If any IPR issue emerges as a result of joint research, then a specific IPR addendum will be jointly agreed upon.

4. Termination

- 4.1. Either of BT-IMSEC or CBPL may terminate this MOU by written notice to the other party. A minimum period of six months notice will be required from a party wishing to terminate the MOU, or such shorter period as the parties may agree upon in writing.
- 4.2. The termination of this MOU shall not affect the implementation of activities that have been undertaken prior to such termination, unless agreements pertaining to such activities explicitly provide for such termination.

5. Amendments and Supplementary Agreements

- 5.1. The parties may agree to amend this MOU at any time by further memorandum in writing executed by the duly authorized officer(s) of each party.
- 5.2. The Parties shall wherever necessary enter into written agreements to facilitate collaborative activities arising from this MOU. Such agreements will specify the details of agreed activities and programs, including the contributions and responsibilities of the parties, funding, intellectual property provisions, confidentiality, risk allocation and indemnity obligations of each party.

6. Use of Name and Logo

6.1. No party shall use, nor permit any person or entity to use, the name or logo (or any variation thereof) of another party without first obtaining prior written consent from the other party. The Parties intend that this provision shall be binding upon them and
