After receiving the written statements on 29th October, 2021 from Mr Kanit Kumar (Roll No 2001430120045, CS1 2nd year student), Proctorial board enquire the whole case and following sequence of events was found:

On 29th October, 2021, Mr Kanit Kumar (CS1 2nd year), Mr Kshitij Saxena (CS2 2nd year) and Mr Shrey (CS2 2nd year) are standing in ground around 1:30pm. These students want to play football with 3rd year students named Mr. Rishabh Sharma (ME 3rd Year), Mr. Utkarsh Sharma (CS1 3rd year), Rachit Sharma (EC 3rd year) but 3rd year students denied for it and hot talked has been started between them.

First Mr. Utkarsh (CS1 3rd year) abused and Mr Rishab (ME 3rd year) beaten to Mr. Kanik and before this Mr Kanik also irritated to them and do misbehaved.

After the investigation and seeing CCTV footage by the proctorial board committee members, it is found that following students were guilty:
